Score Bench Guide for Parents

Each team will provide one competent scorer. You are considered an official for that game and must remain neutral.

SUBSTITUTIONS

- *All player substitutions are to be made through the bench
- *Press the “siren” button on the referees next whistle & signal to the referee with crossed arms above your head
- *Substitutions cannot be done after a goal, UNLESS the referee has blown their whistle due to a violation/foul
- *Once a player has their 4th personal foul please let their coach know
- *Once a player has their 5th personal foul, they will need to exit the court immediately and be replaced by a substitute player. You may press the siren button to attract the referees attention.
- *No player substitutions are allowed in the last ONE minute of the first half

CLOCK STOPPAGE

- *Under 8's - 21's
- *The clock stops for all whistles in the last 3 minutes of the second half and restarts once the ball is passed in and in a players possession

TIME OUTS

- *One “time out” per team, per half. Push the “siren” button on the referees next whistle and signal to the referee which team is electing the time out. Mark this on the score boards.
- *No “time outs” allowed in the last one minute of the first half

TEAM FOULS

- *A player's individual foul gets recorded next to their name on the score sheet (computer) AND as a collective team foul on the viewing scoreboard. Once the 9th team foul has been reached please signal to the referees to let them know
